Organizational ethics basically is the study of what constitutes right and wrong behavior, or good and bad, human conduct in the organizational context. It is a simple definition, however, the analysis of which takes up volumes. But even this simple definition doesn't answer one essential question: Is ethical behavior in the context of business "black or white" or are there areas of "grey"?
